GUIDELINES

Deadline for all posters and paper submissions is **November 8, 2007.**

1. Abstracts for poster and paper submissions should provide a summary of completed research that addresses an issue relevant to the field of neuroscience. Abstracts should be no more than 300 words. Abstracts for five minute faculty talks will be quite short.
2. Abstract submissions should include title, authors, affiliations, and first author's e-mail address. Please indicate whether the presentation author is a faculty member or a student.
